

ENCORE IN MOTION

The audience are on their feet: Cheering, clapping, whistling. The noise is deafening. And now... this is it. One last time. It's the Encore.

Late 2024, marked the end of an era: the final orders were taken for regular production Sevens, which would be powered by the Ford Sigma engine. For more than fifty years of near continuous production, Ford's humble 1.6-litre four-cylinder engines have pulsed at the heart of the Caterham Seven. But no more. With the Sigma's final curtain call, we had said goodbye to naturally aspirated, small-capacity Ford power forever.

Well, so we thought.

But when an engine has played such a pivotal role in the company's story, it deserves a send-off worthy of its legacy. Backstage, hidden in the wings, twenty-five engines remained; waiting for one last, grand finale.

Ladies and gentlemen, make some noise...

This, is the Seven 310 Encore.

Only TWENTY-FIVE Seven 310 Encores will ever be built.

And like any great finale, the best is saved for last. The 310 represents the most powerful incarnation of the Ford Sigma: 152bhp at 7,000rpm. Raceproven for years in the Seven 310R championship, this is the Sigma at its finest.

With 281bhp/tonne on tap, that's around 15% more than the latest Porsche 911 Carrera, the Seven 310 Encore is capable of lapping Donington in under 1m18s. Heavy metal it certainly isn't, but the Encore definitely rocks...

But any good performance needs a show. To bring the curtain down in style, Encore arrives in six special edition colour schemes, each pairing a distinctive paint finish with retroinspired decals. Beneath the skin, Encore is no one-hit wonder. A lightened flywheel helps the free-revving engine bring your drive alive, while vented discs with red quad piston calipers will bring the show to a stop like a mic drop. If this tempts you to take to the track (where the Seven is best), then the central fuel filler cap, aggressive 620 aero nosecone and CUP grille are just what you need. Meanwhile, in the cockpit, uniquely trimmed leather seats bearing the Encore logo, keep you secure but comfortable behind the carbon-fibre dash.

With its rarity, distinctive styling, and carefully considered enhancements, the Caterham Seven 310 Encore is destined to become a collector's gem - a fitting celebration of the Ford Sigma's indelible mark on Caterham history.




